private college in North Dakota to study drama. While there she absorbed herself in the curriculum, which included acting, directing, producing, scriptwriting, and stage makeup. 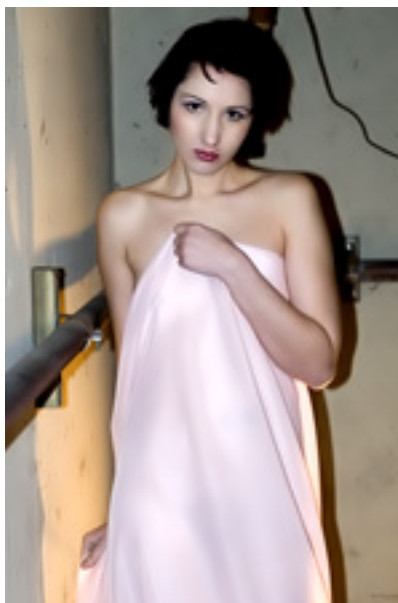
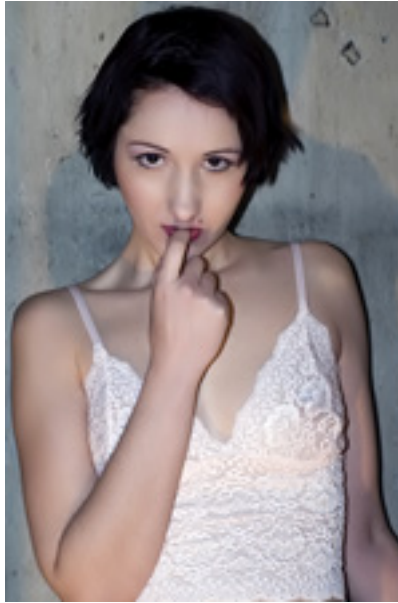
